As a general rule, people who prepare in advance have the most success and the easiest time finding their apartment. Whether you are applying for an apartment in a rental, co-op or condo building, you will most likely need the following documents, which you should bring with you in an envelope to any apartment viewings.

Completed Rental Application Varies by management
Government Issued Photo Identification Passport, state ID of drivers license
Letter of Employment Verifying length of employment, position and total compensation. If self employed, a CPA letter is needed.
Bank Statements most recent, both checking and savings
Pay Stub Three most recent
Tax Return Last two years, first two pages only
W-2 Last two years
Good Faith Deposit generally \$1000 or one month's rent, varies by management
Application Fee generally \$100 per person, varies by management
